### *Quarry School Wood*

The landowner plans to place a 'Lorries Turning' warning sign to warn road users approaching the quarry entrance downhill.

### *Lime tree at Dunchideock bridge*

This was planted over 100 years ago. It is being surveyed to assess its condition and safety.
